If your hat has not been tagged please bring it to the secretary who will tag it for a £2.00 charge. Hats will be checked in the Collecting Ring and if not tagged competitors will be unable to start. Please check you are wearing a Level 3 back protector up to the correct standard for team chasing

Car passes will be sent only on receipt of an SAE. In the event of a team withdrawing before their allotted starting time, there will be no refund of or against entry fees.

PLEASE NOTE: Entry Fee includes a levy payable to the Administrating Body of Team Chasing.

CLASS 1 - INTERMEDIATE FUN TEAM CHASE

ENTRY FEE: £100 PER TEAM

Prizes: 1st - £100; 2nd - £90; 3rd - £80; Rosettes to 6th place

Special Prizes:

- 1. BEST GERIATRIC TEAM:** Riders ages must total at least 160 years
- 2. BEST HUNT TEAM:** Riders must all be Members, Subscribers or Farmers of the same Hunt
- 3. BEST JUNIOR/SCHOOL TEAM:** Riders must be under 16 years of age

The first three teams will not be eligible for any of the above Special Prizes. Teams may only win one prize.

Fixed fences will be approx. 3'3" and the course will be approx. one and a quarter miles. Teams may be of three or four horses. The time of the third horse over the finish will be the time for the team. The team finishing in a time nearest the bogey time, judged to be a fair hunting pace will be the winner. Horses must be 14.2 h.h. or over and must be five years old or over. Riders must have attained their 14th birthday.

CLASS 2 - INTERMEDIATE SPEED TEAM CHASE

(Final of The Combe Farm Wine National Team Chase League)

ENTRY FEE: £120 PER TEAM

Prizes: 1st - £160; 2nd - £140; 3rd - £120; 4th £100 Rosettes to 6th place

Fixed fences will be approx. 3'3" and the course will be approx. one and a quarter miles. Teams may be of three or four horses. The time of the third horse over the finish will be the time for the team. The fastest team will be the winner. Horses must be 14.2 h.h. or over and must be five years old or over. Riders must have attained their 16th birthday.

CLASS 3 - NATIONAL TEAM CHASE OPEN QUALIFIER

(Qualifier for the Material Change National Team Chase Championships)
(Final of The Combe Farm Wine National Team Chase League)

ENTRY FEE: £140 PER TEAM

Rosettes to 6th place

Prizes: 1st - £600 + The Foxcote Trophy; 2nd - £300; 3rd - £200; 4th - £120; 5th - £100
The Jonah Cup, kindly donated by The Hon. Mrs. Mark Vestey, will be awarded to the fastest round by a member of the Cotswold Hunt or Cotswold Hunt Pony Club.

Fixed fences will be approx. 3'6" and the course will be approx. one and a half miles. Teams may be of three or four horses. The time of the third horse over the finish will be the time for the team. The fastest time will be the winner. Horses must be 14.2 h.h. or over and must be five years old or over. Riders must have attained their 16th birthday.

CLASS 4 - NOVICE FUN TEAM CHASE

(Incorporating the Coxwell-Rogers Uniformed Services Military Cup)

ENTRY FEE: £100 PER TEAM

Prizes: 1st - £100; 2nd - £90; 3rd - £80

Rosettes to 6th place

Special Prizes:

1. BEST COTSWOLD TEAM:

Riders must be Members, Subscribers or Farmers in the Cotswold Hunt

2. BEST GERIATRIC TEAM:

Riders ages must total at least 160 years

4. BEST HUNT TEAM:

Riders must all be Members, Subscribers or Farmers of the same Hunt

7. BEST JUNIOR/P.C./SCHOOL TEAM:

Riders must be under 16 years of age. School and P.C. members must all be in the same School or Pony Club

8. BEST ARMED FORCES TEAM:

The Coxwell-Rogers Military Cup will be awarded to the fastest team from Her Majesty's Armed Forces. Riders in this section must be serving or retired members of Her Majesty's Armed Forces. They may enter as unit/service teams or as composite military teams. Only unit/service teams may compete for the Military Cup but all teams will compete for prizes and rosettes to 3rd place

The first three teams will not be eligible for any of the above special prizes. Teams may only win one prize.

Fixed fences will be approx. 2'9" and the course will be approx. one and a quarter miles. Teams may be of three or four horses/ponies. The time of the third horse/pony over the finish will be the time for the team. The team finishing in a time nearest to the bogey time, judged at a fair hunting pace, will be the winner. **Only the Military Section will be won by the team with the fastest time.** Horses/ponies must be 13.2 h.h. or over and must be four years old or over. Riders must have attained their 12th birthday.

TEAM CAPTAINS MUST ENSURE THAT ALL TEAM MEMBERS HAVE A COPY OF THESE RULES

ADMINISTRATIVE LOCAL GUIDLINES

- 1 Any horse eliminated or retiring must leave the course at a walk.
- 2 In the event of a tie the prize money will be divided.
- 3 Competitors may exercise their horses only in the area provided.
- 4 Riders and owners of horses must obey any order or direction given by an Authorised Official of the Event.
- 5 The order of running will be drawn and any team or rider failing to start at their appointed time, for any reason will be eliminated and their entry fees forfeit.
- 6 In the event of cancellation, a refund of Entry Fees will be made for all Classes, less an administration charge of £20 per team.
- 7 Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 8 Small children should remain under the care and be the responsibility of their parents.
- 9 Team Captains must declare their teams at least 30 minutes prior to their appointed starting time and register any change of horse or rider. Teams must report to the Collecting Ring 10 minutes prior to their appointed starting time.

It is a requirement that all participants carry Third Party Insurance for not less than £5 million.
