Riders will be held responsible for adhering to any rule affecting themselves or their horses.

Particular attention should be paid to Safety and Protection – Crash Helmets & Body Protectors

Age, horse welfare, abuse of horses, exchanging horses, personal accident insurance

It is strongly recommended that all participants have Personal Accident Insurance

Classes 1 & 2 Results will be judged on Faults and a Timed Section - Fastest Time.

No horse or pony may compete more than once in each class.

These Classes are open to members of Pony Club, Affiliated Riding Clubs and non-members with their own Insurance.

CLASS 3, 4 & 5 Teams must consist of 3 or 4 riders.. Results will be judged on the time of the 3rd Horse through the finish, this will be the time for the team.

It is a requirement that all participants carry third party insurance for not less than £5m.

CLASS 3 & 4 Results will be judged on Fastest Time. All riders must be 16 years and over on the day of the event. All horses must exceed 14.2 hands.

CLASS 5 Results will be judged on a Bogey Time set at a FAIR HUNTING PACE.

EVENT ADMINISTRATION

- 1/ Entries can only be accepted if they are submitted with the correct Entry Fee .
- 2/ Unless Fees are received in full competitors will not be permitted to take part.
- 3/ Any Competitor jumping a fence (other than the practice fence) prior to the competition will be disqualified.
- 4/ The organisers reserve the right to return or refuse any entry.
- 5/ The organisers and the landowners do not accept liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, grooms, spectators or any person or property whatever on the ground. All vehicles are parked at the owner's risk. No responsibility can be accepted for damage to or loss from those vehicles moving or parking on the premises.
- 6/ Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 7/ Number Cloths should be collected from the Secretaries Box. Team classes please ensure that each rider wears the correct colour and notify the Secretary of any changes to the original entry. A refundable Deposit of £10 per team will be required. £5 for Hunter Trial Classes.
- 8/ Competitors shall report to the Collecting Ring Steward 15 minutes before their Start Time. Any team not running in programme order will be penalised by a 30 second penalty.
- 9/ Exchanging horses is not allowed after a competitor has started.
- 10/ The organisers reserve the right to:

Withhold any Prizes because of insufficient declared entries

Alter the Advertised Times

Eliminate any competitor not adhering to the rules

- 11/ In the event of a dispute the Steward's decision is final. Any competitor wishing to lodge an objection must first deposit £40 with the Secretary and make their objection in writing. If upheld the deposit will be refunded.
- 12/ In the event of a Postponement due to any unforeseen circumstances No Refund of Entry Fees can be made. In the event of Cancellation 50% of Entry Fees will be returned.
- 13/ Veterinary Surgeons & Farriers will be on the field during the competition and competitors will be required to pay for any services received.
